There are many elements of the recently passed CARES Act that can help support short term financial needs of non-profit businesses, including churches. There are also elements that provide financial relief to employees impacted by layoffs or an inability to work due to caring for a child or ill family member. Also, to help churches meet “payroll costs”, including the cost of health premiums and retirement plan contributions, federally backed low interest loans are available to cover up to 2½ months of eligible costs.
