

Special Enrollment Opportunity for Supplemental Life

Starting today through July 31st, The Hartford is offering EPC basic group life participants a special enrollment period to purchase additional life insurance for themselves, their spouse, and dependents at our group policy rates. This one time enrollment period is **for life insurance only through the Hartford; our annual Open Enrollment period for all other plans will be held in the fall.**

If you are eligible* to participate in this special enrollment period, you should have received an email from the Hartford today, July 1st, with more information on how to enroll. A flyer was also sent by regular mail with information on how to take advantage of this opportunity.

Take this time to review your current situation and personal needs, and then determine the right amount of coverage for you and your family. During this enrollment period, you will be able to add as much as \$150,000 in additional life insurance coverage to your current coverage. Participants 65 and older will have lower coverage limits.

The best thing about this special enrollment opportunity is that no Evidence of Insurability (EOI) will be required when adding the supplemental Life coverage, if you meet the eligibility requirements*. **Coverage elected during this enrollment period will be effective September 1, 2020.**
