- → Teledoc virtual physician visits previously listed on your ID card at a \$10 co-pay has been replaced by 98point6 at \$0 copay. See the medical benefit section on our website <a href="here">here</a> for info on 98point6 and how to register.

### **2021 EPC Medical Benefit Highlights**

- → \$0 co-pay for Virtual Primary Care Physician visits through 98Point6. Click <a href="here">here</a> to register and become visit ready.
- → \$0 co-pay for preventative care such as annual physicals, vaccines (including COVID-19), and screenings (e.g., diabetes, colon cancer). See the Preventative Care list here.
- → Behavioral Health visits will no longer be subject to the deductible in our PPO Plans, you will pay a co-pay only for each visit. No change with our 2 high deductible health plans.

## 2021 EPC Rx Benefit Highlights

- → Remember, present your Express Scripts ID card (not medical) whenever you are purchasing a prescription medication or receiving a vaccine (including COVID-19) at a pharmacy.
- → For a substantially lower co-pay always ask your doctor to prescribe a generic medication when available and appropriate for you.
- → Once you have satisfied the initial deducible any co-pay will always be the lesser of the actual medication cost or the stated co-pay.
- → EPC Benefit Resources has expanded its copay subsidy program for plan participants using expensive specialty medications adding 120 additional medications to the list. Our plan administrator will automatically notify you if your medication's manufacturer is offering the subsidies and your co-pay may be reduced to \$0!

#### **ADMINISTRATOR CORNER**
