You can have a virtual primary care physician (PCP) visit from your home right now using your smart phone or mobile device.

You are automatically enrolled in **98point6** but will need to register prior to your first visit. If you are already "visit ready" open your App and start your visit. If you have not yet registered to be "visit ready" then download the App by clicking here and register, then you will be "visit ready" to start your visit from the App. If you are enrolled in our traditional medical plan your co-pay is \$0, and only \$5 if you are in our high deductible plan.

#### **FREE COVID-19 TEST KITS**

The US Government recently announced that all Americans can order **free** at-home Covid-19 rapid tests through the government website, <u>COVIDtests.gov</u>. Every household can receive 4 test kits. Please take advantage of this great **no-cost** benefit. It is so simple to order. Just follow these steps:

- Click <u>here</u> to order or copy and paste <u>https:/www.covidtests.gov/</u> into your browser.
- 2. Provide your name and address. Your email address is optional.
- 3. Click submit and you will receive 4 test kits within 7-12 days after you submit your order.

If you <u>don't</u> want to order online then here are some other options for you:

- → Testing sites at No-Cost or Low-Cost. There over 20,000 sites nationwide.
  - To find a testing site near you click <u>here</u> or copy and paste the link <u>https://www.hhs.gov/coronavirus/ community-based-testing-sites/index.html</u> into your browser or go directly to the government site by typing in this link <u>www.hhs.gov/coronavirus</u>.
- → You can purchase at-home test kits at local pharmacies and the cost will be covered by your EPC health plan. But do keep in mind that your benefit plan will be paying the full cost of the kits. So getting free kits paid for by the government or using a no cost test site will save your plan those costs.
- → If you purchase a test kit through another mail order or retail outlet you may be able to file a paper claim to seek reimbursement through your medical benefit.

#### **Your New ID Cards**

If you have any dependents that live away from home you can forward ID Cards to them! You can also view, print, or email a copy through the <a href="Meritain Health">Meritain Health</a> website. Click <a href="Mereta">here</a> to watch a video to see how to view and print. Initial ID Cards that were mailed to member addresses included cards for all dependents 18 or older.

### **Tip—Preparedness for Natural Disasters**

Documents such as tax returns, birth certificates, deeds, titles, and insurance policies should also be duplicated and kept with a trusted person outside the area a natural disaster may affect.
