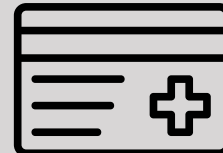

-  Your ID card can be used for both your medical visits and prescription orders at your pharmacy.
-  Always show your ID card to health care providers so they can quickly access your health plan benefits and help you get the most value for your plan.
-  If you lose your card or need a replacement call the Meritain Health customer service team at 800.925.2272 and request a replacement. You can also log in to your Meritain Health portal and print a copy of your card while you wait for your replacement.
