Dear Dr. Jeremiah

The Presbytery of the Pacific requests that the General Assembly approve the following adjustment to the common boundary between the Presbytery of the Pacific and the Presbytery of the West. This adjustment is 1) to accommodate a request from the EPC church in Kingman AZ to be included in the Pacific Presbytery for the travel convenience of the officers of the church when attending presbytery meetings and to recognize the fact that most of its members are retired from California and therefore have a strong affinity for that community, and 2) to provide a more rational and easily defined common border between the two presbyteries. To accomplish this, we request that: ***The eastern border of the Presbytery of the Pacific be defined as the 114°W meridian of longitude between the southern border of Canada and the northern border of Mexico effective July 1, 2017.***

The Presbytery of the West has concurred with this request and has provided a letter to that effect.
